New Publication Grants Program

The Carl & Marilyn Thoma Art Foundation is pleased to announce a new initiative to support museum and university press publishing projects. Beginning on June 15, 2020, the Foundation's new [Publication Grants Program](#) will provide grants to projects that offer significant original scholarship in the fields of digital and electronic art, art of the Spanish Americas, post-war painting and sculpture, Japanese bamboo, and arts and culture of the American Southwest. At the core of the Publication Grants Program is a deep commitment to advancing scholarship and providing broad and equitable dissemination of knowledge and ideas.

Publication Grants are intended to assist with production-related expenses. Eligible costs include author's fees, editing, image rights and permissions, photography, design, printing, and translation. Museums and university presses are eligible to apply.
