To whom it may concern,

This letter is a testimonial to the amazing, high-quality, and creative work produced by Daruma Tech. The Museum of Discovery and Science contracted Daruma Tech to create a cross platform app designed to showcase the work of the Museum's App-titude students. These students were enrolled in a special two year long immersive coding and app development program in collaboration with Florida Atlantic University.

The goal of this program was to create an app for students by students about the Museum's exhibits. Over 150 students from 28 high schools worked in teams to study each exhibit hall and to create a total of 10 exhibit mini apps. Each app included videos virtual reality, and augmented reality assets.

Daruma Tech's role in this project was to create the container app, make sure all of the AR assets worked properly, and to place the app in both the Apple and Android stores. Daruma also created the AR targets for the augmented reality scavenger hunt as well.

Spring boarding on the success of the grant funded App-titude program, the Museum hired Daruma Tech again to work on a theatrical, technology based, science show called *Panther Prowl*. In this arrangement, the Museum was subcontracted by the Florida Panthers hockey team to promote their panther conservation initiatives. The integration of science theater combined with an augmented reality scavenger hunt is a very innovative way to deliver content in the Museum industry.

More recently, I had to call on Daruma to help create a presentation to the Superintendent of Broward County Schools, Mr. Robert Runcie. The problem was there was very little time and no budget to create this augmented reality presentation. Daruma stepped up to the plate and hit a home run for the Museum. They generously provided staff time and equipment to make this high level and extremely important meeting very successful.
